Member Friendship Centres have the right under the BCAAFC Bylaws to appoint one (1) Director to the BCAAFC Board of Directors. The authority of Directorship is appointed to an individual and is non-transferable. The appointment process can be defined by the Member, however the duration and timing of the appointment is set by the Association.
